Commemorating the 20th Anniversary of Steven Spielberg's Oscar winning film, *Schindler's List*, the USC Shoah Foundation - The Institute for Visual History and Education is sponsoring the IWitness Video Challenge. The Institute invites middle and high school students in the U.S. and Canada to act on the legacy of *Schindler's List*, and its message that one person can make a difference. Students are encouraged to do something positive in their community that was inspired by the voices in IWitness, and then construct a video essay with the IWitness video-editing tool that showcases how they contributed to making a positive impact.

USC Shoah Foundation will fly the IWitness Video Challenge winner student, a guardian/parent, and teacher to Los Angeles in March 2014 to screen the video essay as part of the Institute's 20th anniversary activities.
